There has been an uptick in positive COVID-19 cases in our community. The Town of Plymouth has identified potential community exposure related to multiple eating establishments in Plymouth as well as Plymouth Regional High School. This has resulted in temporary closure of several eating establishments as well as the Plymouth Regional High School. We continue to work with all involved to ensure that their re-openings are as safe as possible. COVID-19 continues to circulate in our communities, so all people need to protect themselves and help prevent further community spread by:

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available.

Avoid close contact with others. When outside your home, keep a distance of at least 6 feet between yourself and others. This is known as social distancing.

Wear a cloth face covering that covers your mouth and nose to protect others when in public areas.

Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze, then throw the tissue in the trash and wash your hands.

Do not touch your eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands.

Stay home if you have a fever or are not feeling well.
